This project will provide a new seismically safe facility for the San Francisco Fire Department.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Project Updates

- Placed concrete curbs and equipment pads at 1st floor on Wednesday, 5/9.
- Applied fireproofing to interior steel at 2nd floor, 3rd floor, and roof tower.
- Finished electrical and plumbing rough-in at 2nd and 3rd floors.
- Installed fire sprinkler piping at 2nd and 3rd floors.
- Finished exterior wall framing at north, west and east elevations.

Activities Week of 5/14/2018 - 5/19/2018

- Concrete pour of curbs and equipment pads at 1st floor scheduled for Monday, 5/14. Watch for traffic control and flaggers.
- Finish exterior wall framing at south elevation.
- Electrical and plumbing rough-in at north, east, and south exterior walls.
- Weekend work is tentatively scheduled to occur on Saturday, 5/19.

Activities Week of 5/21/2018 - 5/26/2018

- Install gypsum sheathing at north, west, east, and south exterior walls. Begin installation of base flashing and weather barrier.
- Weekend work is tentatively scheduled to occur on Saturday, 5/26.

Other Information

- SFFD is responding from nearby Fire Stations 6 and 38;
 fire service will continue uninterrupted.
