This project will provide a new seismically safe facility for the San Francisco Fire Department.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Project Updates

- Placed concrete curbs and equipment pads at 1st floor on Monday, 5/14, and Saturday, 5/19. Concrete work is complete.
- Fireproofing of interior steel at 2nd floor, 3rd floor, and roof tower is complete.
- Electrical and plumbing rough-in at exterior walls is complete.
- Installed metal door frames at exterior elevations.
- No weekend work is scheduled to occur on Saturday, 5/26.**

Activities Week of 5/28/2018 - 6/2/2018

- No site activity on Monday, 5/28, in observance of the Memorial Day holiday.**
- Lane closure at Turk Street until 6/5 for new main electrical service connection. Watch for traffic control and flaggers.
- Installation of interior metal stud framing at 1st floor.
- Installation of gypsum sheathing and weather barrier at exterior walls.
- Weekend work is tentatively scheduled to occur on Saturday, 6/2.**

Activities Week of 6/4/2018 - 6/9/2018

- Begin installation of curtain wall at north elevation.
- Weekend work is tentatively scheduled to occur on Saturday, 6/9.**

Other Information

- SFFD is responding from nearby Fire Stations 6 and 38; fire service will continue uninterrupted.
