Project Updates

- Install underground plumbing and fuel piping.
- Layout deck penetrations on 3rd floor level for utilities.
- Install and weld metal decking at roof level.
- Install rebar for 3rd floor slab.
- Concrete pour at 2nd floor slab is scheduled for Friday, 2/2. Watch for traffic control and flaggers.
- **Weekend work is tentatively scheduled to occur on Saturday, 2/3.**

Activities Week of 2/5/2018 - 2/10/2018

- Install underground plumbing and fuel piping.
- Install rebar for roof deck.
- Concrete pour at 3rd floor slab is scheduled for Thursday, 2/8. Watch for traffic control and flaggers.
- **Weekend work is tentatively scheduled to occur on Saturday, 2/10.**
